ORDER REQUESTING UPDATE

On January 31, 2023, El Paso Electric Company filed a statement of intent and application for approval of proposed Texas electric vehicle ready pilot programs and tariffs, which include the (1) EV Smart Rewards Pilot Program, (2) Whole House EV Pilot Incentive Credit Rider, (3) the Power Connect Pilot Program, and (4) the Take Charge TX Pilot Program.

After the parties filed lists of issues to be addressed in this docket, the governor signed Senate Bill 1002 (SB 1002),¹ which addresses the operation of public electric vehicle charging stations and will go into effect on September 1, 2023. In light of SB 1002, El Paso Electric Company must file a statement in this docket by **September 23, 2023** regarding whether it intends to amend its application; withdraw or refile its application; or proceed with its application as filed.
