SECOND ORDER REQUESTING LISTS OF ISSUES

On January 31, 2023, El Paso Electric Company filed a statement of intent and application for approval of proposed Texas electric vehicle (EV)-ready pilot programs and tariffs, which include the (1) EV Smart Rewards Pilot Program, (2) Whole House EV Pilot Incentive Credit Rider, (3) Power Connect Pilot Program, and (4) Take Charge TX Pilot Program.

On September 22, 2023, El Paso Electric Company amended its application and filed supplemental testimony in response to the Commission's order requesting update filed on August 24, 2023. Specifically, El Paso Electric Company's amended application addresses the implementation of SB 1002 on September 1, 2023.

The Commission may issue a preliminary order that will contain a list of the issues to be addressed in this docket, as well as any necessary statement of Commission policy, precedent, or position on any threshold legal or policy issues relevant to this proceeding. To assist the Commission in drafting that order, El Paso Electric Company must, and Commission Staff and any other interested party may, file in this docket a list of issues to be addressed in the docket by **October 12, 2023**. This pleading may also identify any issues that should not be addressed in the docket and identify any threshold legal and policy issues that should be briefed for purposes of a preliminary order. Specific explanations shall support any issues not to be addressed or threshold issues identified in the pleading. Parties shall not file responses to any pleading submitted in response to this Order, unless specifically requested.

If the Commission issues a preliminary order, it will provide a list of issues and areas that must be addressed in this proceeding and any necessary statement of Commission policy, precedent, or position on threshold issues, or combination thereof, relevant to this proceeding. The Commission may consider and possibly adopt a preliminary order in this docket at a future open meeting.
