

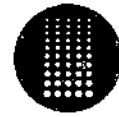

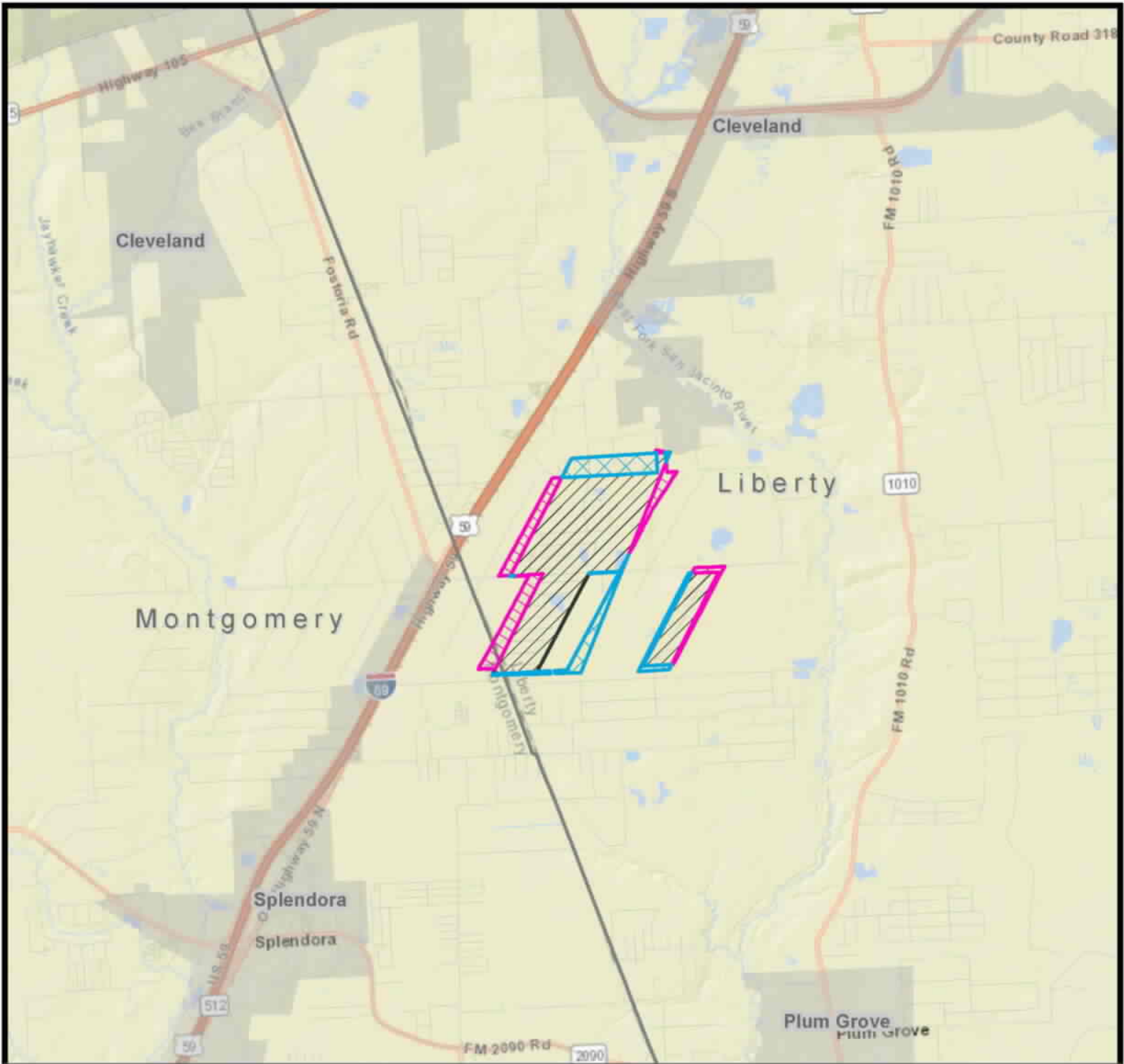

Requested Area - General Location

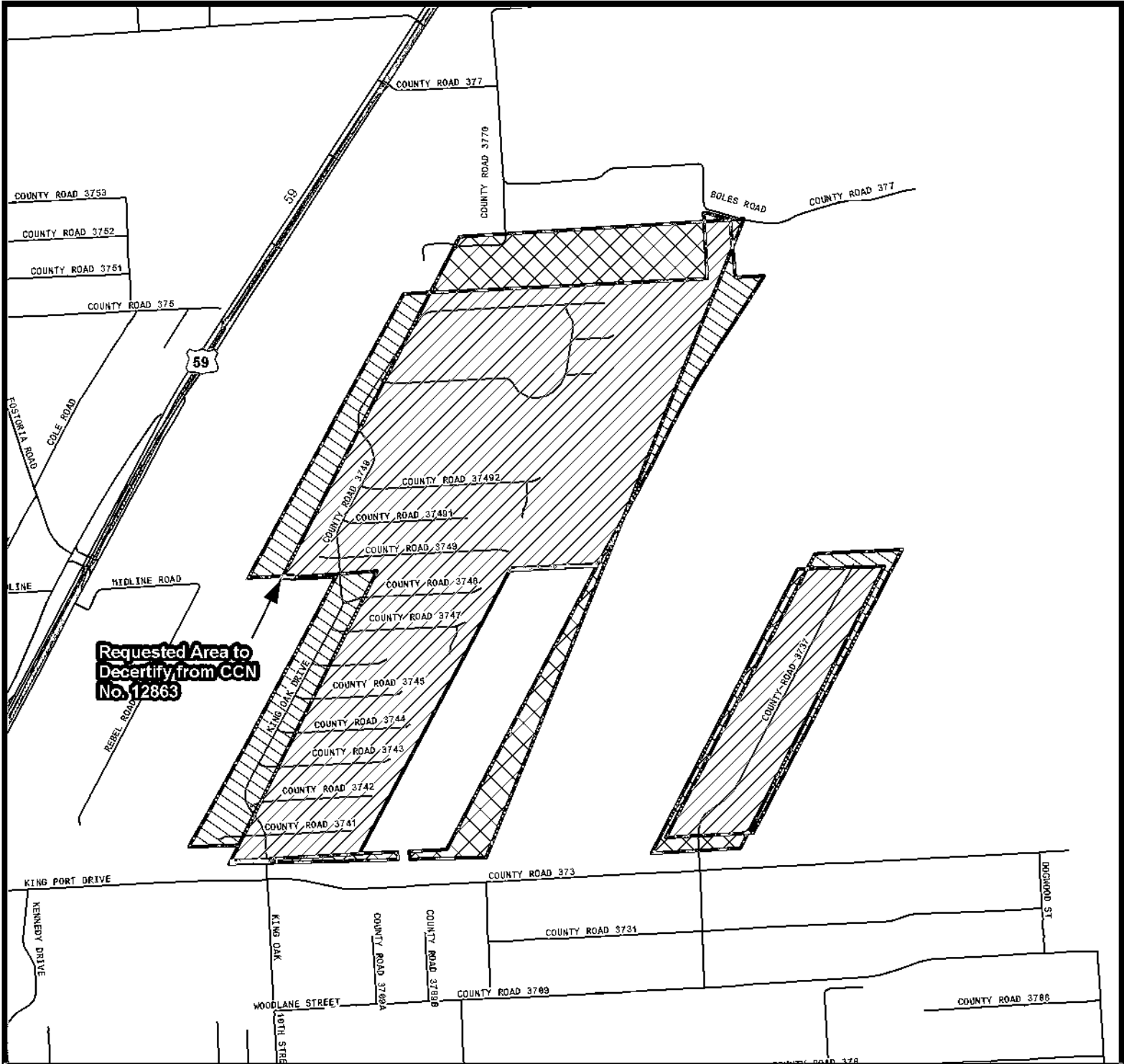

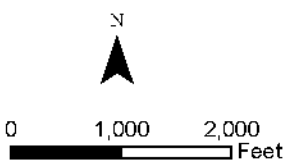


Requested Area - Detail Location
