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II. PURPOSE OF DIRECT TESTIMONY

- Q. ON WHOSE BEHALF ARE YOU TESTIFYING?
- A. I am testifying on behalf of myself.

- A. The purpose of my direct testimony in this proceeding is to intervene in the TWU initial tariff rate that would put a burden on myself and people already struggling to pay their bills. We are losing our rights and "just and reasonable" or for the "public interest" is being taken away.

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Most of the customers do not understand what this is about "rate shock" is an understatement. Others were lost in the intimidating legal process and language problems. I am an administrator on our subdivision community wall and so many have asked me questions that I could not answer. They have no clue.
