**PARKVIEW WATER SUPPLY REQUEST FOR AN EXTENSION**

COMES NOW, Parkview Water Supply (Applicant) files this Request for Extension and would show the following:

**I. BACKGROUND**

Applicant filed an application for a class D rate adjustment on February 14, 2021. On March 8, 2023, Commission Staff filed a copy of a 10-day letter to Parkview describing deficiencies in the application and the information needed to cure the deficiencies. Thereafter, Parkview failed to respond and the administrative law judge (ALG) issued Order No. 2 requiring Parkview to cure deficiencies by April 10, 2023. On April 10, 2023, the ALG issued Order No. 3 granting Parkview's request for an extension.

**II. REQUEST FOR EXTENSION**

Pursuant to 16 Texas Administrative Code (TAC) § 22.4(b), Applicant may request that the time allowed for filing any documents be extended for good cause. Currently, the ALG Order No. 3 requires Applicant to cure its application by Thursday, April 27, 2023. Applicant is currently working to file an application for a name change from TNJ Corporation to PCS Development however the application is not yet complete. Further, Applicant does not have the information to adequately complete the 2021 Class D annual Report in Project No. 52954. Prior to July 2022, the Applicant was in the process of selling the system to Andrew Larson and was under the assumption, incorrectly, he had filed the report. At this time, the current operator, L&M Operators, does not have the information to fill out the report. Applicant requests time to work with Staff to determine the best path forward to resolve the deficiency. Therefore, Applicant respectfully requests an extension to cure deficiencies to May 12, 2023.

**III. CONCLUSION**

Applicant respectfully requests the issuance of an order granting Applicant's request and extending the deadline for Applicant to cure the deficiencies to May 12, 2023
