
**SOAH ORDER NO. 6
REMANDING TO COMMISSION**


On June 24, 2024, the Administrative Law Judges (ALJs) granted in part and denied in part the joint motion of Enviro-Management and staff (Staff) of the Public Utility Commission of Texas (Commission) seeking to admit evidence, dismiss intervenors, and remand this proceeding (Joint Motion). The ALJs admitted the items identified by Enviro-Management and Staff, including their Stipulation and Settlement Agreement (Settlement Stipulation), but denied their request to dismiss non-participating parties¹ and to remand the proceeding.

¹ The non-participating parties are Louis Goss, Yvonne Weaver, and Mark Newton.

Instead, the ALJs provided a final opportunity for the non-participating parties to file notice in this docket by July 1, 2024, stating whether they are opposed or unopposed to the Settlement Stipulation. No objections or other motions were filed by the non-participating parties by the deadline. As such, the ALJs conclude there is no opposition to the Settlement Stipulation that resolves all issues in this proceeding or the Joint Proposed Order, attached to the Joint Motion as Exhibit A. Accordingly, this case is **DISMISSED** from the docket of the State Office of Administrative Hearings and **REMANDED** to the Commission for final processing and approval.
