Docket No. 54683; Application of Enviro-Management for Authority to Change

Rates

The Office of Policy and Docket Management (OPDM) seeks clarification that requires a response from the parties.

Enviro-Management's existing tariff includes a \$0.07 pass-through rate per 1,000 gallons used. During this proceeding, Enviro-Management requested that the pass-through rate be raised from \$0.07 to \$0.10 per 1,000 gallons used.¹ The revised proposed tariff attached to the parties' joint response to Order No. 9 does not have a pass-through rate listed but includes language regarding how to calculate pass-through rates in the pass-through clause provision.²

Regarding the revised proposed tariff attached to the parties' joint response to Order No. 9, please file a response to state: 1) that the revised proposed tariff accurately reflects the parties' agreement with respect to pass-through rates; or 2) that the revised proposed tariff should be further revised to accurately reflect the parties' agreement with respect to pass-through rates. OPDM is not inquiring into settlement negotiations but only seeks a response to confirm whether the revised proposed tariff accurately reflects the parties' agreement with respect to pass-through rates.

OPDM requests clarification responses by **noon on Wednesday, November 6, 2024**. If the parties intend to file a second revised proposed tariff, please confirm whether it can be filed on or before Wednesday, November 20, 2024, along with a motion to admit it as additional evidence.
