**APPLICATION OF ENVIRO- § PUBLIC UTILITY COMMISSION

CHANGE RATES § OF TEXAS**

JOINT CLARIFICATION

On February 24, 2023, Enviro-Management filed an application for authority to change water rates under Texas Water Code §§ 13.1871 and 13.1872(c)(2). Enviro-Management is a Class D water utility with 137 active connections and holds Certificate of Convenience and Necessity No. 12625.

On October 31, 2024, the Office of Policy and Docket Management (OPDM) filed a memo, directing the Staff (Staff) of the Public Utility Commission of Texas (Commission) and Enviro-Management to file clarification responses by November 6, 2024. Therefore, this pleading is timely filed.

I. JOINT CLARIFICATION

Staff and Enviro-Management (collectively, the Parties) jointly clarify that the proposed tariff without the revised pass-through rate is correct. Although Enviro-Management originally requested that the pass-through rate be raised by \$.03 per 1,000 gallons used, in the interest of settlement, Enviro-Management agreed to forgo the pass-through rate modification and instead request the pass-through modification in a separate filing.

II. CONCLUSION

The Parties jointly clarify that the proposed tariff filed on September 30, 2024, is correct and respectfully request that OPDM take the foregoing into consideration.
