ORDER NO. 2
FINDING APPLICATION INCOMPLETE, ESTABLISHING
OPPORTUNITY TO CURE AND SUSPENDING EFFECTIVE DATE

This Order addresses the sufficiency of the February 24, 2023 application of Enviro-Management for authority to change rates under Texas Water Code (TWC) §§ 13.1871 and 13.18715. On March 27, 2023, Commission Staff filed a recommendation on the administrative completeness of the application and notice.

The Commission finds the application incomplete and deficient. The Commission does not consider an application filed until it makes a determination that the application is administratively complete. Thus, at this time the application is not considered filed with the Commission.

By April 28, 2023, Enviro-Management must supplement the application to cure the deficiencies identified in James Onyeneke's March 27, 2023 memorandum attached to Commission Staff's recommendation of the same date. Further, under TWC § 13.1871(e) and 16 Texas Administrative Code § 24.33(b)(1), Enviro-Management's proposed effective date is suspended until an administratively complete application is submitted. Until the Commission receives and reviews the supplemental information, the application cannot proceed.

By May 12, 2023, Commission Staff must file a supplemental recommendation regarding administrative completeness, along with a proposed procedural schedule, if appropriate.
