COMMISSION STAFF'S REQUEST FOR EXTENSION

I. INTRODUCTION

On February 24, 2023, Enviro-Management filed an application for authority to change water rates under Texas Water Code §§ 13.1871 and 13.1872(c)(2). Enviro-Management is a Class D water utility with 110 active connections and holds Certificate of Convenience and Necessity No. 12625.

On May 17, 2023, the administrative law judge (ALJ) filed Order No. 3, directing the Staff (Staff) of the Public Utility Commission of Texas to clarify the discrepancy the ALJ identified in Order No 3 and to provide a new supplemental recommendation on notice, if appropriate, by May 26, 2023.

II. REQUEST FOR EXTENSION

Under 16 TAC § 22.4(b), Staff may request that the time allowed for filing any documents be extended for good cause. Staff needs more time to draft a new memorandum addressing issues it had addressed in its March 27, 2023 pleading and to draft an accompanying clarification as requested by the ALJ. Accordingly, Staff respectfully requests that Staff's deadline to file a clarification be extended to June 2, 2023. Staff has conferred with Enviro-Management and is authorized to represent it is unopposed to the extension request.

III. CONCLUSION

Staff respectfully requests the entry of an order extending Staff's deadline to file a clarification to June 2, 2023.
