PROPOSED PROCEDURAL SCHEDULE

On February 24, 2023, Enviro-Management filed an application for authority to change water rates under Texas Water Code (TWC) §§ 13.1871 and 13.1872(c)(2). Enviro-Management is a Class D water utility with 110 active connections and holds Certificate of Convenience and Necessity (CCN) No. 12625.

On November 29, 2023, the State Office of Administrative Hearings (SOAH) administrative law judge (ALJ), held a prehearing conference, during which parties were ordered to submit a joint proposed procedural schedule by December 1, 2023. Therefore, this pleading is timely filed.

I. PROPOSED PROCEDURAL SCHEDULE

Per the SOAH ALJ's instructions, parties were expected to confer and submit a joint proposed procedural schedule. Parties consist of Staff, the applicant, and six intervenors. Five of the six intervenors were admitted as intervenors during the November 28, 2023 prehearing conference and Mark Newton was admitted as an intervenor in Order No. 6. During the November 28, 2023 prehearing conference, all parties, except for Mark Newton who did not attend the prehearing conference, discussed and tentatively agreed to proposed dates for a procedural schedule, which are reflected below. Since Staff only had Mr. Newton's contact information, Staff gave the intervenors its email address and asked intervenors to send Staff their contact information, so Staff could share a written version of this procedural schedule with all intervenors. To date, Staff has only received contact information emails from John Franklin, Rhonda Kay Bynum, and Deborah Davis, and Staff has only received a response to its proposed procedural schedule email from Ms. Davis, who had no objections. Staff also shared this proposed procedural schedule with

Staff notes that the original date shared for intervenor testimony or statement of position was January 24, 2023. This has since been revised to give intervenors more time to review discovery responses before submitting their testimony or statements of position. All other dates have remained the same.

Enviro-Management but has not heard back. Nevertheless, in the interest of abiding by the SOAH ALJ's deadline, Staff submits the following proposed procedural schedule:
