COMMISSION STAFF'S RECOMMENDATION ON THE APPLICATION AND NOTICE

I. INTRODUCTION

On March 3, 2023, Albury Manor Utility Company, Inc. (AMUC) filed an application under 16 Texas Administrative Code (TAC) § 24.25(b)(2) for approval of a pass-through rate change for certain districts related to a decrease in direct costs associated with North Harris County Regional Water Authority's water pumpage fees.

On March 6, 2023, the administrative law judge (ALJ) filed Order No. 1, directing the Staff (Staff) of the Public Utility Commission of Texas (Commission) to file a recommendation on the sufficiency of the application and notice by April 3, 2023. Therefore, this pleading is timely filed.

II. RECOMMENDATION ON THE APPLICATION

Staff has reviewed the application and recommends that it is sufficient for further review. Staff does not comment on the merits of the application at this time.

III. RECOMMENDATION ON NOTICE AND AMUC'S GOOD CAUSE EXCEPTION REQUEST

Staff has reviewed the notice provided by AMUC and recommends that it be deemed sufficient. Staff has also reviewed AMUC's request for a good cause exception to 16 TAC § 24.25(b)(2)(F). Because AMUC's proposed pass-through rate change will decrease customer charges, Staff recommends that AMUC's good cause exception request be granted, and that if this application is approved, the pass-through rate change be effective February 1, 2023.
