taxes. These taxes are not available for general fund items through the City such as street repair, water/sewer work as directed by the State of Texas. Each year the Eastland City Commission sets aside \$35,000 for the grants.

In the past the City of Eastland has awarded grant funds of over \$339,851 for structural repairs and or façade restoration to properties located within the downtown Historic District in projects totaling more than \$591,681. The grants are a matching award based on the work requested and funds available. Grants paid out in the past have included matches of 50/50 to 75/25. In an extreme case a 100% grant has been awarded where structural integrity was at risk.
