## ORDER NO. 2 FINDING APPLICATION ADMINISTRATIVELY INCOMPLETE AND ESTABLISHING DEADLINES AND OPPORTUNITY TO CURE

This Order addresses the administrative completeness of the March 21, 2023 petition of Cash Special Utility District and Royse City for approval of a service-area contract under Texas Water Code § 13.248 and to amend certificates of convenience and necessity in Rockwall County.

On April 21, 2023, Commission Staff filed a recommendation regarding the sufficiency of the application and recommended the style of this docket be corrected to show the correct name for the City of Royse City.

The administrative law judge (ALJ) finds the application administratively incomplete and deficient. Under 16 Texas Administrative Code § 24.8(d), the Commission does not consider the application filed until it makes a determination that the application is administratively complete. Thus, at this time the application is not considered filed with the Commission.

By May 19, 2023, the applicants must supplement the application to cure the deficiencies as described in the April 21, 2023 memorandum of Jaspinder Singh. Until the Commission receives and reviews the supplemental information, the application cannot proceed. The applicants must not issue notice until the application is found administratively complete.

By June 23, 2023, Commission Staff must file a supplemental recommendation regarding the administrative completeness of the application, along with a proposed procedural schedule, if appropriate.

The ALJ restyles the docket as requested, consistent with this Order.
