COMMISSION STAFF'S RECOMMENDATION ON ADMINISTRATIVE COMPLETENESS AND NOTICE AND PROPOSED PROCEDURAL SCHEDULE

On March 31, 2023, the City of Donna (City) filed an application to amend its Certificate of Convenience and Necessity (CCN) in Hidalgo County. City holds water CCN No. 20825.

On May 2, 2023, the administrative law judge (ALJ) filed Order No. 2, directing the Staff (Staff) of the Public Utility Commission of Texas (Commission) to file a supplemental recommendation on the administrative completeness of the application, along with a proposed procedural schedule by July 1, 2023¹. Therefore, this pleading is timely filed.

I. ADMINISTRATIVE COMPLETENESS

Staff has reviewed the application and supplemental information and, as detailed in the attached memorandum from Chase Lipscomb, Infrastructure Division, recommends that the application continues to be incomplete from a managerial and technical perspective. Staff further recommends that the City be ordered to cure the deficiencies identified Mr. Lipscomb's memorandum by August 1, 2023 and that Staff be given a deadline of September 5, 2023 to file a supplemental recommendation on the administrative completeness of the application.

Staff respectfully requests adoption of these proposed deadlines as some of the noted deficiencies are related to mapping information and Staff's mapping experts may be required to assist the City regarding the supplemental mapping information needed to cure the mapping deficiencies and will require at least thirty days to review same.

 $^{^{1}}$ July 1, 2023 is a Sunday and therefore a day on which the Commission is closed for business. Accordingly under 16 TAC § 22.4(a) the deadline moves to the next day the Commission is open for business, which is Wednesday, July 5, 2023.

П. PROCEDURAL SCHEDULE

In accordance with Staff's deficiency recommendation, Staff does not propose a procedural

schedule for further processing of the docket at this time. Staff intends to propose a procedural

schedule alongside a subsequent recommendation that the application be found administratively

complete. Staff notes that the City should not issue notice until the application is deemed sufficient.

Ш. **CONCLUSION**

For the reasons detailed above, Staff recommends that the application be found

administratively incomplete and that the City be ordered to file supplemental information to cure

the deficiencies in the application by August 1, 2023 and Staff be given a deadline of September

5, 2023 to provide a supplemental recommendation. Staff respectfully requests the entry of an

order consistent with these recommendations.

RE: Docket No. 54813 – Application of the City of Donna to Amend Its Certificate

of Convenience and Necessity in Hidalgo County

On March 31, 2023, the City of Donna filed with the Public Utility Commission of Texas (Commission) an application to amend its sewer Certificate of Convenience and Necessity (CCN) No. 20285 in Hidalgo County, Texas under Texas Water Code (TWC) §§ 13.242 through 13.250 and 16 Texas Administrative Code (TAC) §§ 24.225 through 24.237.

Based on the mapping review and my technical and managerial review of the additional information filed by the City of Donna on 6/7/2023. I recommend that the application be deemed administratively incomplete and not accepted for filing.

Application Content:

Please provide a copy of your last Comprehensive Compliance Investigation (CCI) report from the Texas Commission on Environmental Quality.

Mapping Content:

The city of Donna did not provide any additional mapping in filing, therefore the maps submitted with Item 1 on March 31, 2023 are still deficient.

The City of Donna must submit the following items to resolve the mapping deficiencies:

- A general location map identifying only the requested area, in reference to the nearest county boundary, city, or town.
- A detailed map identifying only the requested area, in reference to verifiable man-made and natural landmarks, such as roads, rivers, and railroads.
- Digital mapping data for the requested area, as a single polygon record, in a shapefile (SHP) format, georeferenced in either NAD83 Texas Statewide Mapping System (Meters) or NAD83 Texas State Plane Coordinate System (US Feet).

Staff recommends the City of Donna obtain additional mapping guidance from the PUC's mapping staff, Hank Journeay by email at hank.journeay@puc.texas.gov to resolve the mapping deficiencies.

Staff will need at least 30 days to review the documentation, maps, and digital data provided by the City of Donna and draft a recommendation.
