ORDER NO. 2
FINDING APPLICATION ADMINISTRATIVELY COMPLETE,
REQUIRING NOTICE, AND ESTABLISHING PROCEDURAL SCHEDULE

This Order addresses the administrative completeness of Quadvest LP's April 5, 2023 application to amend its certificates of convenience and necessity (CCN) numbers 11612 and 20952 in Harris County.

On June 5, 2023, Commission Staff filed its recommendation on administrative completeness.

The administrative law judge (ALJ) finds the application administratively complete and directs the petitioners to provide notice of the application as described in the June 4, 2023 memoranda of James Harville and David Lopez, attached to Commission Staff's recommendation.

In addition and in light of Commissioner Jackson's memorandum in Docket No. 51646,¹ the ALJ emphasizes and clarifies the requirement for notice to owners of 25 acres of land that is wholly or partly included in the requested area. Quadvest must confirm by affidavit that notice has been mailed by first class mail to each owner of a tract of land that is at least 25 acres and is wholly or partially included in the area proposed to be certified according to the most current tax appraisal rolls of the applicable central appraisal district at the time the Commission received the application for the amendment. Proof of notice that includes the names and mailing address but does not identify which tracts of land in the requested area are at least 25 acres and who owns those tracts of land is not sufficient evidence of notice, as required under Texas Water Code § 13.246(a-1) and 16 Texas Administrative Code § 24.235(b)(2).²
