UNOPPOSED REQUEST FOR EXTENSION

On April 5, 2023, application of Quadvest, LP (Quadvest) filed an application to amend its certificate of convenience and necessities (CCN) in Harris County. Quadvest holds water CCN No. 11612 and sewer CCN No. 20952.

On August 22, 2023, the administrative law judge (ALJ) filed Order No. 4, establishing a deadline of September 22, 2023, for the Staff (Staff) of the Public Utility Commission of Texas (Commission) to file a final recommendation on the application. Therefore, this pleading is timely filed.

I. UNOPPOSED REQUEST FOR EXTENSION OF TIME

Under 16 Texas Administrative Code § 22.4(b), a party may request that the time allowed for filing any documents be extended for good cause. Staff and Quadvest are continuing to collaborate to fully complete the application and need additional time to coordinate a supplemental filing. Staff respectfully request an extension of time until November 22, 2023. Staff has conferred with Quadvest and can represent Quadvest is unopposed to this request.

II. CONCLUSION

Staff respectfully request the entry of an order extending Staff's deadline to November 22, 2023, to file a final recommendation on the application.
