COMMISSION STAFF'S REQUEST FOR EXTENSION

I. INTRODUCTION

On April 5, 2023, application of Quadvest, LP (Quadvest) filed an application to amend its certificate of convenience and necessities (CCN) in Harris County. Quadvest holds water CCN No. 11612 and sewer CCN No. 20952.

On February 27, 2024, the administrative law judge (ALJ) filed Order No. 8, directing the Staff (Staff) of the Public Utility Commission of Texas (Commission) to file a final recommendation on the application by March 22, 2024. Therefore, this pleading is timely filed.

II. REQUEST FOR EXTENSION OF TIME

Under 16 Texas Administrative Code § 22.4(b), a party may request that the time allowed for filing any documents be extended for good cause. Quadvest has filed supplemental material that Staff is currently reviewing and requires additional time to fully prepare a final recommendation. Staff respectfully request an extension of time until April 22, 2024, to file a final recommendation on the application. Staff has conferenced with Quadvest and can represent they are unopposed to this request.

III. CONCLUSION

Staff respectfully request the entry of an order extending Staff's deadline to April 22, 2024, to file a final recommendation on the application.
