**ORDER NO. 2**  
**FINDING APPLICATION ADMINISTRATIVELY INCOMPLETE AND**  
**ESTABLISHING DEADLINES AND OPPORTUNITY TO CURE**

This Order addresses the administrative completeness of the April 21, 2023 application of Crosswinds Municipal Utility District, the City of Kyle, and Texas Water Utilities, LP for approval of a service-area contract under Texas Water Code § 13.248 and to amend certificate of convenience and necessity (CCN) numbers 11024 and 12983 in Hays County.

On May 24, 2023, Commission Staff filed its recommendation on administrative completeness.

The administrative law judge finds the application administratively incomplete and deficient. Under 16 Texas Administrative Code (TAC) § 24.8(d), the Commission does not consider the application filed until it makes a determination that the application is administratively complete. Thus, at this time the application is not considered filed with the Commission.

By June 23, 2023, the applicant must supplement the application to cure the deficiencies as described in the May 24, 2023 memorandum of James Harville. Until the Commission receives and reviews the supplemental information, the application cannot proceed. The applicants must not issue notice until the application is found administratively complete.

By July 24, 2023, Commission Staff must file a supplemental recommendation regarding the administrative completeness of the application, along with a proposed procedural schedule, if appropriate. Further, Commission Staff must address whether this docket should be re-styled.
