MEMORIALIZING PREHEARING CONFERENCE;

On December 5, 2023, a prehearing conference convened in this matter. Appearing through counsel were the applicant, Staff of the Public Utility Commission of Texas, and the Office of Public Utility Counsel.

The ALJ established the based on a proposed effective date of June 19, 2023, the 265 day suspension ends on March 10, 2023. Nevertheless, the applicant agreed to further suspend the effective date until November 1, 2023.

1. Drafts of testimony and discovery responses and emails containing drafts of testimony and discovery responses are not discoverable.
2. Filing and service to be completed as per the Commission's existing orders; email service to the parties is sufficient.
3. Discovery Deadlines:
 - a. Deadline for Written Discovery on Direct Testimony:
 - i. Responses are due within seven calendar days of the discovery request;
 - ii. Objections are due within seven calendar days of the discovery request;
 - iii. Motions to compel are due within three calendar days of the objection(s); and
 - iv. Responses to motions to compel are due within two calendar days of the motion to compel.
 - b. Deadline for Written Discovery on Integra rebuttal and Staff and Intervenor's Cross- Rebuttal Testimony:
 - i. Responses are due within five calendar days of the discovery request;
 - ii. Objections are due within three calendar days of the discovery request;
 - iii. Motions to compel are due within two calendar days of the objection(s); and
 - iv. Responses to motions to compel are due within two calendar days of the motion to compel.


