**SOAH ORDER NO. 6**  
**ADOPTING INTERIM RATES; SETTING DEADLINE TO FILE A**  
**STATEMENT OF POSITION**

On March 7, 2024, Integra Water Texas, LLC, Staff of the Public Utility Commission of Texas, and the Office of Public Utility Counsel (collectively, the Signatories), filed a Joint Motion to Admit Evidence and Remand. Simultaneously, these parties filed a joint motion for interim rates and a Stipulation and Agreement (Agreement) that resolves all issues in this proceeding. These filings indicate that two remaining parties—Keila Cruz and Emma Delao<sup>1</sup>—did not respond to attempts to contact regarding settlement.


## **I. INTERIM RATES**

The Signatories request an order approving interim rates, subject to refund or surcharge to the extent that they differ from the final rates, equal to the settled rates under the Agreement, as reflected in the agreed tariff, Attachment A to the motion, effective March 15, 2024. The request for interim rates is GRANTED.

## **II. DEADLINE FOR STATEMENTS OF POSITION**

The two remaining parties did not appear at the prehearing conference and have not responded to attempts to contact. The ALJ defers ruling on the joint motion to admit evidence and remand until the remaining parties state their positions. Therefore, **no later than March 14, 2024**, Keila Cruz and Emma Delao SHALL file statements of position in accordance with 16 Texas Administrative Code section 22.124. **Failure to comply with this requirement may result in dismissal as a party from this proceeding.**
