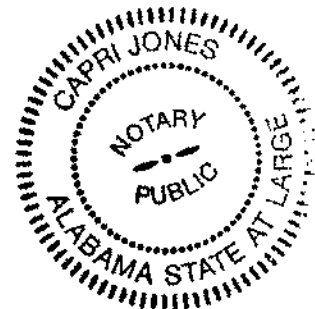

Pursuant to 16 Texas Administrative Code (“TAC”) § 25.109, Southern Power Company (“Southern Power”) hereby submits the following information in support of the registration of Salt Fork Wind LLC (“Salt Fork Wind”) as a Power Generation Company (“PGC”) with the Public Utility Commission of Texas (“Commission”). Southern Power, a subsidiary of Southern Company, is a leading wholesale energy provider meeting the electricity needs of municipalities, electric cooperatives, investor-owned utilities, and commercial and industrial customers. Southern Power and its subsidiaries own or operate 53 facilities – including natural gas, wind, solar, battery storage and fuel cells – operating or under construction in 14 states with approximately 12,500 megawatts (“MW”) of generating capacity. Southern Power owns five wind and three solar generation facilities totaling approximately 1,360 MW of generating capacity in Texas, in some cases with minority investors. Salt Fork Wind is a 174 MW wind generation facility located in Donley and Gray Counties, Texas. The wind facility is wholly owned by Salt Fork Wind, a Delaware limited liability company. Salt Fork Wind’s corporate parent is Southern Power, which owns 100% of Class B Shares at a holding company level, with the Class A Shares owned by a non-controlling tax equity investor. **NOTICE OF SELF-CERTIFICATION OF
EXEMPT WHOLESALE GENERATOR STATUS**

Pursuant to Section 366.7 of the Federal Energy Regulatory Commission's ("Commission") regulations¹ implementing the Public Utility Holding Company Act of 2005, enacted by the Energy Policy Act of 2005,² Salt Fork Wind, LLC ("Salt Fork") hereby submits this notice of self-certification that it is an exempt wholesale generator ("EWG") based on its ownership and operation of a 174 MW nameplate wind-powered electric generating facility to be located in Gray and Donley Counties, Texas (the "Facility") with the sale of its output at wholesale.

II. DESCRIPTION OF APPLICANT

Salt Fork is a limited liability company organized under the laws of the State of Delaware, with its principal place of business in Gray and Donley Counties, Texas. It is indirectly wholly-owned by EDF Renewable Energy, Inc. (“EDF-RE”). Salt Fork is developing and will own and operate the Facility to be located in Gray and Donley Counties in Texas.

The Facility will consist of wind turbines and related facilities necessary to interconnect to the transmission system operated by the Electricity Reliability Council of Texas. (“ERCOT”). All of the output of the Facility will be sold exclusively at wholesale.

EDF-RE develops, builds, operates and manages renewable energy projects throughout North America. EDF-RE is wholly owned by EDF Energies Nouvelles S.A., a French société anonyme, a company organized under the laws of France, which in turn is wholly owned by Électricité de France, S.A. (“EDF SA”), which is owned by the French government (84.49%), with a small percentage of shares held by the employees (approx. 1.80%) and the remaining shares owned by the public.

III. SELF-CERTIFICATION OF EWG STATUS

Consistent with the Commission’s regulations, Salt Fork makes the following representations in order to demonstrate that it meets the Commission’s definition of an EWG under Section 366.1 of the Commission’s regulations³ for its energy sales from the Facility.

1. Salt Fork will be engaged directly and exclusively in the business of owning or operating, or both owning and operating, all or part of one or more “eligible facilities” and selling electric energy at wholesale, and the Facility will satisfy the

definition of an “eligible facility” because it will be used for the generation of electric energy exclusively for sale at wholesale.

2. Salt Fork will not own any transmission facilities other than those interconnection facilities that are necessary to effect the wholesale sale of electric energy from the Facility, consistent with Commission precedent construing the definition of “eligible facility” under Section 32(a)(2) of the Public Utility Holding Company Act of 1935 (“PUHCA 1935”).

3. No rate or charge for, or in connection with, the construction of the Facility, or for electric energy produced thereby, was in effect under the laws of any State on October 24, 1992. Accordingly, no State determination is required with respect to this filing.

4. There are no lease arrangements through which Salt Fork will lease the Facility to a public utility company or any other party.

5. Salt Fork does not sell electricity at retail to any customer. Accordingly, the Facility does not rely on the exception provided by Section 32(b) of PUHCA 1935 regarding foreign sales of power at retail.

6. No portion of the Facility will be owned or operated by an “electric utility company” that is an “affiliate” or “associate company” of Salt Fork.

In accordance with Section 366.7(a) of the Commission’s regulations, a copy of this Notice is concurrently being served upon the Public Utility Commission of Texas.

IV. CONCLUSION

For the foregoing reasons, Salt Fork respectfully requests that the Commission accept this Notice of Self-Certification of EWG Status.
