## ORDER NO. 8 MOTION TO DISMISS

The ALJ is of the opinion that this matter should be dismissed under 16 Texas Administrative Code (TAC) § 22.181(d)(8), because Driftwood Water Conservation, LLC has failed to state a claim for which relief can be granted. The basis for dismissal and the material facts supporting dismissal under 16 TAC § 22.181(d)(8) are summarized in this Order.

In this proceeding, Driftwood Water is seeking to be registered as an exempt water utility. Under Texas Water Code § 13.242(c) and 16 TAC § 24.229(e), such a registration is possible for a water utility that has *less than* 15 potential service connections. In its application, Driftwood Water states it has 15 potential service connections, making it unavailable for certification as an exempt utility.

Under 16 TAC § 22.181(a) and (e), dismissal of a proceeding may be made upon the motion of the ALJ. This Order constitutes such a motion.

If Driftwood Water wishes to respond to the ALJ's motion to dismiss, it must do so by February 14, 2024.
