REQUIRING RESPONSE**

This Order addresses Order No. 8, the motion to dismiss, filed on January 25, 2024 and Driftwood Water Conservation, LLC's filing on January 29, 2024.

The administrative law judge (ALJ) requires Commission Staff to file a response to both filings by February 14, 2024. The ALJ notes that the applicant has, at various times, alleged eight active connections and eight potential connections (presumably meaning a total of 16 connections), eight active connections and seven potential connections (presumably meaning a total of 15 connections), zero active connections and 15 potential connections, and zero active connections and 14 potential connections. Among other things, Commission Staff must address the criteria by which the number of "potential connections" in an application for exempt utility registration is determined.
