**ORDER NO. 4**  
**FINDING APPLICATION ADMINISTRATIVELY COMPLETE,**  
**REQUIRING NOTICE, AND ESTABLISHING PROCEDURAL SCHEDULE**

This Order addresses the administrative completeness of the May 25, 2023 application of City of Fort Worth to amend its certificates of convenience and necessity number 12311 in Tarrant County. On July 26, 2023, and September 14, 2023, the applicants filed supplemental information.

On October 25, 2023, Commission Staff filed its supplemental recommendation on administrative completeness.


The administrative law judge (ALJ) finds the application administratively complete and directs Fort Worth to provide notice of the application as described in the October 25, 2023 memorandum of Jaspinder Singh attached to Commission Staff's recommendation.

The ALJ adopts the following procedural schedule:

Deadline for Fort Worth to file with the Commission signed affidavits that the notice was given along with a copy of the notice and map sent to the affected parties and published in a newspaper of general circulation	December 11, 2023
Deadline for Commission Staff to file a recommendation on sufficiency of notice and propose a schedule for continued processing, if appropriate.	December 21, 2023
Deadline to intervene	30 days after last date notice is issued
