ORDER NO. 2
FINDING APPLICATION ADMINISTRATIVELY INCOMPLETE AND
ESTABLISHING OPPORTUNITY TO CURE

This Order addresses the May 25, 2023 petition of the City of Fort Worth to amend its sewer certificate of convenience and necessity number 12311 and for dual certification with the City of Hurst in Tarrant County.

On June 26, 2023, Commission Staff filed a recommendation regarding the sufficiency of the application.


The administrative law judge finds the application administratively incomplete and deficient. Under 16 Texas Administrative Code § 24.8(d), the Commission does not consider the application filed until it makes a determination that the application is administratively complete. Thus, at this time the application is not considered filed with the Commission.

By July 26, 2023, the applicant must supplement the application to cure the deficiencies as described in the June 26, 2023 memoranda of Jaspinder Singh and Fred Bednarski, attached to Commission Staff's recommendation. Until the Commission receives and reviews the supplemental information, the application cannot proceed. The applicant must not issue notice until the application is found administratively complete.

By August 25, 2023, Commission Staff must file a supplemental recommendation regarding the administrative completeness of the application, along with a proposed procedural schedule, if appropriate.
