THE CITY OF FORT WORTH’S RESPONSE TO ORDER NO. 3

COMES NOW, the City of Fort Worth, by and through its counsel, and respectfully files
“The City of Fort Worth’s Response to Order No. 3”

I. BACKGROUND

On May 25, 2023, the City of Fort Worth (“Fort Worth”) filed an application to amend Certificate of Convenience and Necessity (“CCN”) No. 12311 and for dual certification with the City of Hurst, CCN No. 10104, (“Hurst”) in Tarrant County (“Application”). On June 26, 2023, Public Utility Commission of Texas (“PUC”) Staff filed “Commission Staff’s Recommendation on Administrative Completeness and Notice and Proposed Procedural Schedule,” which contained memoranda by Jaspinder Singh and Fred Bednarski III (“Memoranda”). On June 26, 2023, the ALJ signed Order No. 2, “Finding the Application Administratively Incomplete and Establishing an Opportunity to Cure.” The City of Fort Worth filed its response to Order No. 2 on July 26, 2023. Commission Staff filed a recommendation regarding the Fort Worth’s response on August 25, 2023. The recommendation included an August 25, 2023 memorandum by Jaspinder Singh. On August 28, 2023, the ALJ signed Order No. 3, finding Fort Worth’s application administratively incomplete, as described in the memorandum by Jaspinder Singh.


II. THE CITY OF FORT WORTH’S RESPONSE TO ORDER NO. 3

In response to the memorandum prepared by Jaspinder Singh, Fort Worth submits a revised general location map, detailed location map, and revised digital mapping data for the requested area. The City coordinated with PUC staff member Hank Journeay to make necessary updates to

both the general location and detailed location maps as well as the digital mapping data. *See* Exhibit “A” for the maps and mapping data.

Therefore, Fort Worth respectfully submits its response to Order No. 3. Fort Worth looks forward to collaborating with PUC staff, as necessary, and is available to supply additional information and answer any questions posed by the agency.



General Location Map


