Commissioners,

After reading the June 8, 2023 testimonies of Mr. Harsh Naik, P.E., Oncor representative and Mr. Russell J. Marusak, with Halff, I wondered if “prudence avoidance” was actually considered concerning the Link J3 ???

Also, in the Commissions Certificate of Convenience and Necessity, Chapter 37, Section 37.056, it states:

(a) The commission may approve an application and grant a certificate only if the commission finds that the certificate is necessary for the service, accommodation, convenience, or safety of the public.

Also, in the same Chapter and Section 37.056, it states:

(A) Community values

(D) Environmental integrity

In the testimony from the TPWD, dated July 19, 2023, it was recommended Route I-37 to the PUC. I have not been able to find the TPWD Route I-37 recommendation on the maps that Oncor sent to us.

Commissioners, I truly think Oncor has not considered the “safety of the public, the community values, or the environmental integrity” of our community, Legacy Ranch, Justin, Texas.

We ask you, the Commissioners, to inquire on our behalf, Legacy Ranch, Justin, Texas, that Oncor STOP the Link J3 segment from being considered in the proposed Ramhorn Hill-Dunham 345 KV Project.
