My name is Luke Oliver and I am one of the many property owners affected by the Oncor J4 transmission line proposal to run through Justin, Texas. I live on the corner of Lakeway Lane and Wilkerson Lane and would sit no further than 150ft from the proposed route of the J4 transmission line.

I would like to formally intervene and present my case as to why the J4 route would be detrimental to not only Justin as a growing community but to the many families who live within a stone's throw of the proposed route.

Justin is a community with traditional roots which has been and continues to grow similar to many other towns and communities in Texas. The residents in Justin are not ignorant to the needs for increased power distribution via transmission lines but it fails to be seen for why Justin has been seriously considered as a potential transmission line passage way.

Needless destruction of woodland along with a spring fed creek, the required foreclosing of many homes within the transmission line perimeter, an eye sore for the entire town of Justin, potential harms to children in nearby schools, detrimental financial harm to many young families and first time homeowners (my family included). All of these are very good reasons why the J4 transmission line should be avoided at all costs.
