I oppose the transmission line routes through and around Canyon Falls Neighborhood, especially the lines proposed through the Laurel section (E8, F2, F3 and C9). These are a direct impact of our family. We paid a premium price for our lot and don't want to see its value depreciate due to the proximity of the proposed transmission lines.

One of the reasons we chose Canyon Falls was because of its amenities. I don't want to see lines C8 and C9 cut through the neighborhood next to the Community Center, splash pad, pool and park that we often visit or C7, E3 and E2 that is proposed to run next to the Pooch Park that host community activities throughout the year as well as where our pets go to run and stretch out their legs.

Aside from our own pets, Canyon Falls is home to a variety of wildlife such as Deer, Ducks, Cranes, Bobcats, Peacocks, Coyotes, Cows, Snakes, Skunks, Turtles, Beavers, various Birds and Fish to name a few. The transmission lines will significantly impact our greenbelts (C7, C8, C9 and E5) and trails in which the wildlife and homeowners enjoy as part of our community. It is what helps relax us from our jobs and busy schedules.

Before messing up the natural topography of Canyon Falls, please consider replacing segment C7 with C6 to follow along 1171.
