To PUC Commissioners Kathleen Jackson, Will McAdams, Lori Cobos, Jimmy Glotfelty, and others whom it may concern,

This statement is with respect to the proposed transmission lines by ONCOR described in SOAH docket number 473-23-21216 and PUC docket number 55067. The particular links of concern are link U2 as it crosses north of County Road 4840 and link R6 where it meets link U2. This statement is my direct testimony regarding the impact of this link on me and my property.



I have owned the property listed as 2528 since 2005 and have resided in the home labelled 966 since 2007. The proposed U2 link of the transmission line shows to be routed to the west of my fence line and property line and out 50 feet from my residence. And the proposed R6 link of the transmission line runs 50 feet to the north of my residence. The proximity of these links to not

only one but to two sides of my home is of great concern to me due to their potential negative impact on my health from continued exposure to electromagnetic energy.



According to an article by Brightsandz Clean Technology the passage of electrical current through a conductor causes extremely low frequency (ELF) radiation. ELF radiation is associated with an increase of childhood leukemia by 200% as well as other health issues including headache, dizziness, fatigue, and insomnia which can then lead to hypertension, irritability, listlessness, decline in energy levels, and obesity. This article concludes that a safe distance for a home from a high voltage (230 – 400 KV) transmission line is 100 meters (about 328 feet). Therefore, my home is NOT located a safe distance from either the proposed U2 link or the proposed R6 link. In fact, my home is well within the hazard zone of 60 meters (about 197 feet). We have family, friends and grandchildren that love to play out here, and enjoy our pool, so the safety hazards of a transmission line are unacceptable.

I realize that expansion is a necessity with the recent and projected population growth in the area, but the impact on my own, my family's, and my friends' well-being is not worth the risk, not to mention the devaluation of my property. It seems that there are many other possible routes that would have less impact on currently occupied homes. There are multiple nearby properties that are either commercial or have unoccupied homes. The neighbors on all sides of us stand strong against this intrusion.

Please consider NOT choosing a route that includes links U2 and R6.
