As active seniors, we made the decision to purchase our "empty nester" home in the Canyon Falls neighborhood because of the lifestyle it would provide for us. Miles of our walking trails would be destroyed if you put the utility line adjacent to Westbridge Road (line E5).

We paid a \$10K premium for our lot, and at the time of our purchase, we were told that the green space view we have from the back of our house would be protected. This would include the beautiful trees and the habitat for animals.

At our age, other concerns are the potential health risks living next to power lines. My husband is a leukemia (CLL) survivor and exposure to these lines can potentially put him at risk of a reoccurrence.
