**SOAH ORDER NO. 7**  
**DENYING REQUEST FOR ROUTE ADEQUACY HEARING**

On July 31, 2023, Deborah N. Dallas (Dallas) filed a statement, including a motion to challenge the adequacy of the routes presented by Oncor Electric Delivery Company LLC (Oncor) in its application<sup>1</sup> and requesting a route adequacy hearing. On August 4, 2023, Oncor responded, stating that Dallas's motion does not actually challenge the adequacy of Oncor's proposed routes in its application; rather, it states her position on the proposed transmission line.
