Comments and Concerns

1) Transmission Lines Emit 'Radiation'

- Currently, Nick is in cancer remission that these high voltage lines can have a long-term health risks from excessive radiation exposure from this project in our backyards which is **unacceptable**. There are many others in our immediate community fighting the same battles.
- One of the reasons we moved to the area was to be far from any lines that could have a negative effect on our health and healing of Nick's cancer, and my continual migraines. Moving out of the city from loud noises and bright lights have also been a reason for us relocating to a quite safer community.
- We have two tweens who are still growing and developing which gives concern to having these radiation emitting lines in our backyard. There are also many young families with active children who live in Legacy Ranch who would also be exposed as they play outside in their yards. Most families also have swimming pools in their backyards.
- I also work from home and spend 24/7 in the area to conduct my work. This will expose me to continual radiation raising much concern to my health.
- Numerous families raise chickens as pets in their backyards while they also provide a food source.
- We have a dog as do mostly every family in our neighborhood who spend a lot of time outdoors in our large lots exposing them to numerous house a day to this radiation, not to mention the constant buzzing sound that is heightened in dogs.
- We also have a large garden as do many of the families in the neighborhood, which we spend hours attending too that is a food source to our families.
- Lots of wildlife and migratory birds including Canadian Geese are in this area.

2) Miscellaneous Concerns

- Constant buzzing sound
- Property values affected

- Metal Fencing around all of our properties (could be an electrical shock hazard during a storm/rain, etc.)
- Potential fire hazard (lightning strikes, etc.)
- Proximity to 8" gas pipelines (could cause induction coupling between the metal pipeline and the magnetic field from the powerlines) Maintenance of the gas pipelines could be negatively impacted.

We moved to Justin, TX in 2020 to have a spacious clean, large lot home away from the city pollution, noise, and disturbances of high voltage lines so that we can provide food source like gardening and chickens, and a safe sustainable, healthy lifestyle for ourselves and our children free from radiation so we can do all we can to be free from my husbands pre-existing cancer.. These lines are detrimental to our communities health and safety of ourselves, neighbors, children, and animals.
