My husband and I purchased our home in Canyon Falls after deciding not to build a home in Seventeen Lakes, 5 miles to the south. The single reason we did not purchase in Seventeen Lakes, was due to the number of large power towers in that edition. If the following segments are approved in Canyon Falls, we will be surrounded by these towers that will obstruct the view from our house; F3 to the west, E8 to the south, and C9 and E5 to the east. We will end up surrounded by the power lines we specifically avoided when we built our home in Canyon Falls. This would negatively and severely impact our quality of life as we and our grandchildren enjoy the openness, trails, and green spaces within Canyon Falls.
