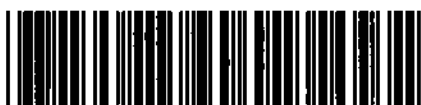





Finally, we did not work ourselves so hard for so many years to pay this place off for Oncor!!!!

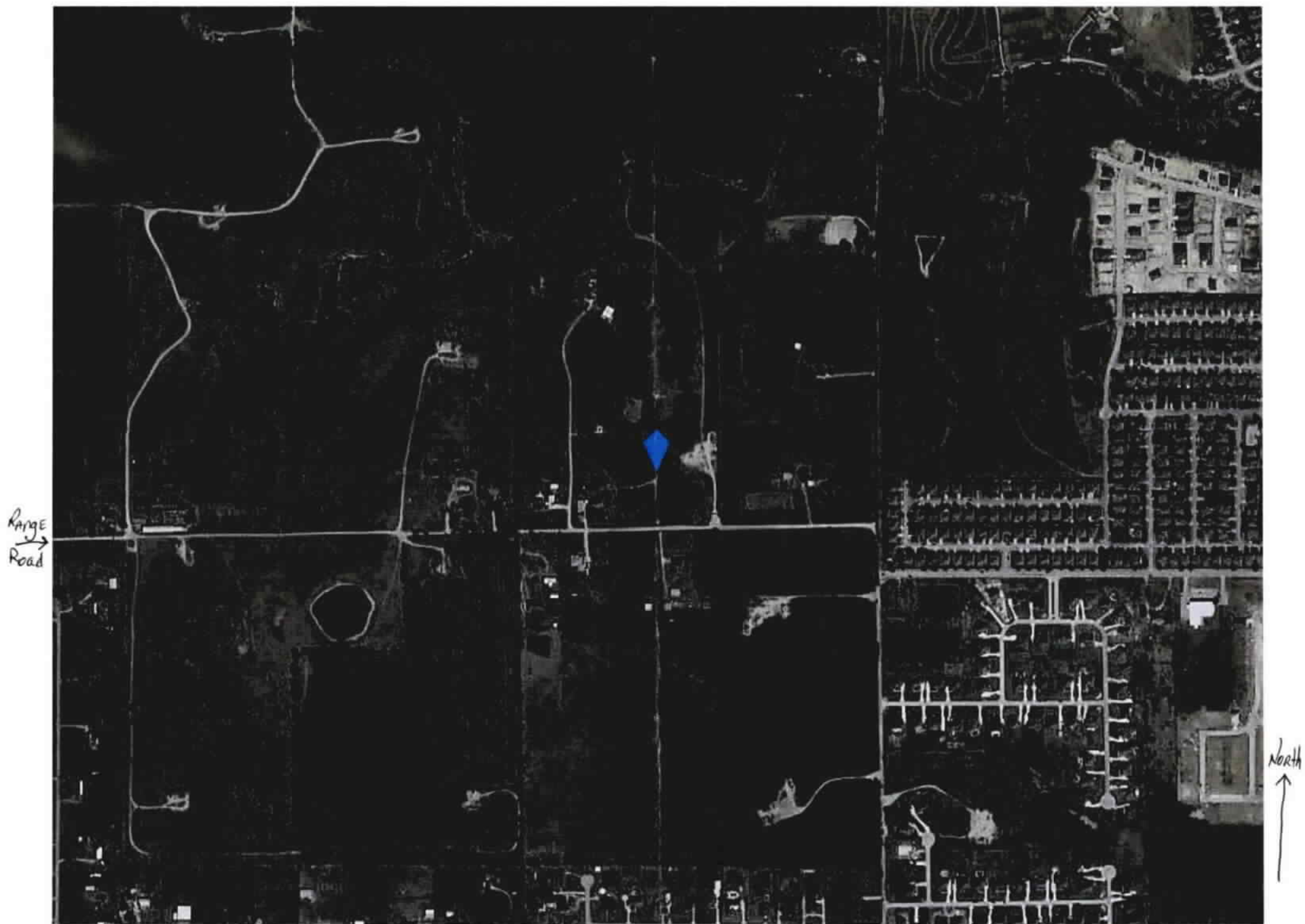
