

RAMHORN HILL – DUNHAM 345K TRANSMISSION LINE PROJECT

TO: Anyone who would have the authority and ability to prevent the creation of such a potentially hazardous and dangerous situation.

I was greatly disturbed when I learned of Oncor's plans to construct the subject project transmission line and towers. My hope was that more safety minded people in the company would prevail. So much so, that I wrote a letter to them on March 7, 2023, stating my concern. This proposed line and towers would be only one-half mile north of Runway 17 at Aero Valley / Northwest Regional Airport (52F). They might be avoidable obstacles during normal operations but for a pilot in distress or night operation it could prove to be disastrous or even fatal.

I and many of my friend's land and depart from this airport almost daily. I urge this commission to disapprove this project in its entirety and recommend a relocation perhaps further north of Highway 1171. It would not even be an issue if it was constructed north of 1171.
