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Dear Commission,

This letter is in protest of the Oncor Transmission Line proposed around Canyon Falls in Northlake (docket 55067).

We moved to Texas in 2022 from Indiana. A major part of our search for a new community to live in was for one that had dedicated pools, clubhouse, trails, parks, ponds, and nature preserves. Canyon Falls has all of these amenities, so when we found a house we liked here, we bought it. We have enjoyed walking the trails, seeing the wildlife, activities at the clubhouse, taking our grandchildren to the parks, etc.

The proposed transmission lines in this area are concerning. Many would significantly impact our community's quality of life (displacing wildlife, affecting the views on the trails, some even crossing the clubhouse and main pool) and therefore the economic value of our homes. There is also the potential/perceived danger to the children of the community, especially along some of the lines. The lines we especially object to because they have the most significant impact are:

- Any option using C8, C5, or E5
- Any option using C7, E8 or F3

Our preferred route is C3 to C6 to E6 to F1 to G3 because that has the least impact on our community. An acceptable compromise would be C23, C4 (particularly if that route was moved further from Kiddie Academy of Northlake), because although it still negatively impacts our quality of life and our home's economic value, it does so to a lesser degree.
