PROPOSED PROCEDURAL SCHEDULE AND OTHER PROCEDURAL MATTERS

On June 8, 2023, Oncor Electric Delivery Company LLC ("Oncor") filed an application to amend its certificate of convenience and necessity for the Ramhorn Hill-Dunham 345 kV transmission line project in Denton and Wise counties, Texas. On June 9, 2023, the Public Utility Commission of Texas ("PUCT") referred this matter to the State Office of Administrative Hearings ("SOAH"). On June 14, 2023, the SOAH Administrative Law Judge ("ALJ") issued SOAH Order No. 1, which, among other things, scheduled a prehearing conference for June 26, 2023, and provided guidelines for drafting a proposed procedural schedule. At the prehearing conference, the parties agreed on a proposed procedural schedule and also addressed other procedural matters, which are addressed more fully below.

I. PROPOSED PROCEDURAL SCHEDULE

Oncor respectfully requests that the SOAH ALJ adopt the following proposed procedural schedule, consistent with the parties' discussion at the preheating conference:

Any intervenor who does not file direct testimony or a statement of position by **July 31**, **2023**, will be stricken as a party under 16 Texas Administrative Code sections 22.124 and 22.161.

II. OTHER PROCEDURAL MATTERS

A. Proposed Discovery Plan

For discovery on Oncor's direct case, the following deadlines apply:

- Responses are due within ten working days of the discovery request; and
- Objections are due within five working days of the discovery request.

For discovery on Intervenor and Staff direct testimony and Intervenor cross-rebuttal testimony, the following deadlines apply:

- Responses are due within five working days of the discovery request; and
- Objections are due within three calendar days of the discovery request.

For discovery on Oncor's rebuttal testimony, the following deadlines apply:

- Reponses are due within five working days of the discovery request; and
- Objections are due within three calendar days of the discovery request.

All discovery requests received after 3:00 p.m. are deemed to have been received the following business day. Additionally, drafts of testimony and statements of position will not be discoverable, nor will emails transmitting drafts of testimony and statements of position be discoverable.

B. Service of Documents

Service will be by the PUCT Interchange System. However, if a filing requires an action of another party, direct service on that party is required. Email service is a valid method of providing direct service on a party from whom action is required.

III. CONCLUSION

Consistent with the parties' agreement at the June 26, 2023 prehearing conference, Oncor

respectfully requests the ALJ adopt the above proposed procedural schedule and procedures.
