Dear Members of the PUC Committee

We are submitting to you on behalf of the residents of Harriet Creek Ranch HOA Signed protest and Intervener sheets from our neighborhood.

We are protesting the Ramhorn Hill -Dunham transmission lines. Specifically: 112 and J22

Our neighborhood has been here since 2002 and we are a small community of 1420 homes that belong to the City of Ft Worth although we have a Justin mailing address.

We weren't aware of the lines until we heard about the meeting in the City of Justin last week, but we urge you to please reconsider and not bring the transmission lines through our Neighborhood. Our Elementary School, school yard and playground of our city park and creek would be right under the lines.

Our trees and wildlife would be adversely affected. We want to preserve our trees as they are home to the many animals in the area that have been routed out of their homes due to new development, one such animal, an Ocelot that was seen not too long ago. Our children currently fish in the creek and play ball in the open field. The nearest Fort Worth City Park is 10 miles away and not all kids would have the same access to go that far.

This is a flood zone and without those trees would it open to more flooding?

We wonder about the flight path of the planes if that has any bearing in your decision since they seem quite low when they are incoming due to the size of freight and military planes.

We have communication towers in the vicinity, would those be any kind of obstruction?

We do understand that development is needed for all, but that is why we ask you to consider routing through areas up north that are barely in the beginning phases of development and can rearrange their planning to avoid the lines.

We are a small voice and realize that you may not listen to us, but we want to try and ask you to please spare this route that affects our children.
