We live in Trailwood in Flower Mound and would be negatively impacted by powerline routes C3 and C6 for the Ramhorn Hill-Dunham 345 KV.

We are adamantly opposed to these routes due to the EMF radiation, which has been linked to Cancer. We are so concerned about the radiation that we specifically bought this house because there were no transmission lines near it. If one of these routes are used, then we will be forced to sell - incurring moving costs and an up to 30% depreciation in our home's value (according to recent studies).

Further, there is increased fire hazard, likely increasing our insurance rates. There is also the noise pollution that comes with the electrical buzzing that typically accompanies high voltage powerlines.

Finally, the lines are just plain ugly to look at! We live in the country with beautiful wooded views that would absolutely be spoiled with the construction of these power lines. Routes C7 and C23 in our area allow Oncor to follow existing powerline routes and avoid all occupied residential communities. Another alternative would be to change C6 so that the powerlines cross 1171 further east and follow C4 to avoid all residential communities.

My wife and I sincerely hope that these powerlines will not be placed near Trailwood. Please avoid all residential communities by following C3 and C6.
