<u>Opposition to the proposed Ramhorn Hill-Durham 345kV</u> affecting the city of Justin.

- 1. It will have a negative impact to the growth of current and future residential/commercial developments in our community. The loss of Bishop Park and the surrounding green space used for community events.
- 2. Loss of trees and all vegetation will destroy the sound barrier between the new town square, restaurants and community activities and the surrounding neighborhoods. Increased erosion and potential for flooding of properties.
- 3. Increased risks of fire(PG&E 2018) and electrocution as well as radiation exposure from the EMF radiation of the high voltage power lines.

Personal Impact (not necessarily in order of importance).

- 1. Low Property Resale Value studies show loss of property values between 10-30% and as much as 40% depending on the voltage of the lines. A loss we personally cannot withstand with the current buying/selling real estate market.
- 2. Power lines and towers are unsightly and will ruin the view of the natural features currently enjoyed.
- 3. Noise pollution due to the loss of the natural sound barrier/increasing erosion and potential flooding of all our

properties. We, as property owners, carefully selected our homes based on quiet surroundings and community.

- 4. High voltage lines produce a constant buzzing/humming sound. The only buzzing sound I want to hear are the bumble bees and additional pollinators.
- 5. Noise pollution due to the loss of the natural sound barrier/increasing erosion and potential flooding of all our properties. We, as property owners, carefully selected our homes based on quiet surroundings and community.
- 6. What has the impact of communication reception ie: cell phone, analog and digital, wifi, & etc.
- 7. Health Research is still ongoing on the health effects of ELF/EMF radiation. As some suggest it has reproductive, carcinogenic, and neurological effects. The electrical and magnetic fields alter our health for both children and adults.
