Hello Neighbors,

We hope you had a Happy 4th!

The protest period for the transmission line routes through and around our neighborhood is passing rapidly. Thus far, we have less than 20 protest or intervention forms submitted. We need to get over 100 to ensure we will prevail. Forms must be eceived by July 24th. You can see our initial filing on the Canyon Falls Resident Facebook page. It doesn't have all the evidence yet that we plan to argue, but it states our intervention's basic outline.

If you live on one of the proposed routes it is imperative that you either send in a Protest/Comments form or Request to Intervene Form – both are attached for your convenience. If you live beyond 500 ft from a proposed line, but are a homeowner in Canyon Falls you can also protest to help protect our greenbelt, clubhouse, and trails. Remember to mention your homeownership on and/or use of the greenbelt and the impact to natural topography, animals and the investment made in preserving this space. Please, also mention the economic impact to home values. Calling out the segments that most impact you is also helpful. Greenbelt routes are C7, C8, C9, and E5. The Pooch Park is closest to C7, E3, and E2. The community center, pool and playground are between C8 and C9. The Kiddie Academy is directly next to C7 on the line running from C23. Segments that impact Laurel are E8, F2, F3, and C9. The segment that impacts Meridian is E5. The segments that impact Deer Run are C5, C7, C8, which run from C22 and C23. We are advocating for replacing segment C7 with C6 to follow along 1171.

Please take a moment to fill out and mail the protest or intervention form. The next page explains the difference between the two. The mailing address is at the top of the form. It takes only 5 min to fill out an effective response. Please post on the Canyon Falls Residents Facebook page and tell us what you wrote so you can help others!

## Oncor Transmission Line Project Information - Docket No. 55067

Oncor Electric Delivery is proposing a new transmission line through southwest Denton County, which would directly affect specific areas of Canyon Falls. We do have maps of the proposed routes and it is imperative that our community, municipalities, and individuals respond via protests to protect against encroachment of their and our assets.

**Property Owner Engagement:** Property owners who wish to engage in the PUCT process can protest or intervene.





Protestors can provide the PUCT with public comments. Although public comments are not treated as evidence, they help inform the PUCT and its staff of the public concerns and identify issues to be explored. The deadline to file a protest is July 24, 2023.

Protests are most effective when they outline what ownership rights are affected, focus on economic and environmental impact, and identify specific losses, i.e., Premiums paid for green belt homes, millions spent on parks and trails, loss of value due to proximity of lines for future sales and environmental habitat lost that was preserved as part of our community. Make sure to note what segment you are protesting. Oncor is recommending a route East/West under the dog park called C7. Northlake is requesting C6 which follows 1171 instead. Mentioning that is beneficial as well as any segment that directly impacts your home such as E5 for Meridian/Laurel, C8 in Ironwood, C8/C5 in Deer Run or E8/C9/F3 in Laurel.

**Intervene:** Intervenors become parties to the case, which means intervenors are required to respond to all discovery requests from other parties in the case, may be cross-examined in the hearing, and more. If a member of the public wishes to intervene, retaining legal counsel is encouraged.
