Dear Mr. Ife Adetoro, Regulatory Manager Oncor Electric Delivery Company LLC., Mayors, City Mangers and Honorable Commissioner

My name is Will Rogers I am a property owner in Aero Valley Estates, the airport community just to the south of your proposed new utility line. I just purchased my property in 2021 and have filed and I am beginning construction on a hanger and new home on my property. When I purchased my property I understood there was a proposed routing plan supported by the Town of Northlake along the 337 route. I am in favor of this proposed utility since it does not adversely affect me or the other residents, property owners or business located on the airport.

However, it is my understanding that there has been a new proposal for the routing of powerlines to the north of our community along 1171, which I oppose. The new route along 1171 will not only potentially devalue my property, but also propose a hazard for me and the other pilots and passengers landing at our airport (52F). My concern is not only in the devaluation, but in the additional hazard of large power line in the event of an airplane on final approach to runway 17 or a plane with a problem on departure from runway 35.

Please let me know if there is anyone else that I can contact regarding my concern and opposition to this matter. Thank you for hearing my concerns and taking them into consideration.
