**ORDER NO. 2
FINDING PETITION ADMINISTRATIVELY INCOMPLETE AND ESTABLISHING
OPPORTUNITY TO CURE**

This Order addresses the sufficiency of the June 14, 2023 joint petition filed by Century Land Holdings II, LLC and GRBK Edgewood, LLC to decertify a portion of Aqua Water Supply Corporation's certificate of convenience and necessity number 10294.

On July 14, 2023, Commission Staff filed a recommendation regarding the sufficiency of the petition.

The administrative law judge finds the petition administratively incomplete and deficient. Under 16 Texas Administrative Code § 24.8(d), the Commission does not consider the petition filed until it makes a determination that the petition is administratively complete. Thus, at this time, the petition is not considered filed with the Commission.

By August 14, 2023, the petitioners must supplement the application to cure the deficiencies as described in the July 14, 2023 memorandum from Chase Lipscomb, attached to Commission Staff's recommendation. Until the Commission receives and reviews the supplemental information, the application cannot proceed. The applicants must not issue notice until the application is found administratively complete.

By September 13, 2023, Commission Staff must file a supplemental recommendation regarding the administrative completeness of the petition, along with a proposed procedural schedule, if appropriate.
