**ORDER NO. 4  
FINDING APPLICATION ADMINISTRATIVELY COMPLETE,  
REQUIRING NOTICE, AND ESTABLISHING PROCEDURAL SCHEDULE**

This Order addresses the administrative completeness of the June 16, 2023 application of the City of Pharr to amend its certificate of convenience and necessity number 20643 in Hidalgo County.

On October 9, 2023, Commission Staff filed its recommendation on administrative completeness.


The administrative law judge (ALJ) finds the application administratively complete and directs Pharr to provide notice of the application as described in the October 9, 2023 memorandum of Jolie Mathis attached to Commission Staff's recommendation.

Deadline for Commission Staff to file a recommendation on sufficiency of notice	December 7, 2023
Deadline to intervene	30 days after last date notice is issued
