**ORDER NO. 2  
FINDING APPLICATION ADMINISTRATIVELY INCOMPLETE AND  
ESTABLISHING OPPORTUNITY TO CURE**

This Order addresses the sufficiency of the June 16, 2023 application of City of Pharr filed to amend its certificate of convenience and necessity in Hidalgo County.

On July 17, 2023, Commission Staff filed a recommendation regarding the sufficiency of the application.


The administrative law judge finds the petition administratively incomplete and deficient. Under 16 Texas Administrative Code § 24.8(d), the Commission does not consider the petition filed until it makes a determination that the petition is administratively complete. Thus, at this time, the petition is not considered filed with the Commission.

By August 17, 2023, the petitioners must supplement the application to cure the deficiencies as described in the July 17, 2023 memoranda from Jolie Mathis and Fred Bednarski, III, attached to Commission Staff's recommendation. Until the Commission receives and reviews the supplemental information, the application cannot proceed. The applicants must not issue notice until the application is found administratively complete.

By September 19, 2023, Commission Staff must file a supplemental recommendation regarding the administrative completeness of the petition, along with a proposed procedural schedule, if appropriate.
