ORDER NO. 8
REQUIRING CLARIFICATION

This Order addresses the June 30, 2023 application of CSWR-Texas Utility Operating Company, LLC and Wood Trails Water Supply, Inc. (collectively, the applicants) for approval of the sale, transfer, or merger of facilities and certificate rights in Kerr County.

In order to further process this docket, the administrative law judge requires clarification in order to make a determination regarding whether CSWR-Texas has the managerial and technical capability to provide continuous and adequate service, as required by Texas Water Code §§ 13.241(a) and 13.301(b) and 16 Texas Administrative Code §§ 24.227(a) and 24.239(j). Specifically, CSWR-Texas must clarify that it has filed all reports required by any governmental agency, including the Texas comptroller's office, the Texas Commission on Environmental Quality, and the Texas secretary of state, and file an affidavit attesting that it is in good standing with all applicable regulatory entities.

By February 29, 2024, CSWR-Texas must file the required clarification and affidavit. Concurrent with its filing, CSWR-Texas must file a motion to admit the clarification and affidavit into the record.
