## ORDER NO. 6 GRANTING EXTENSION

This Order addresses Atlantic Energy Texas LLC's October 25, 2023 request for an extension of time to cure the deficiencies in this application. Atlantic Energy states that the Electric Reliability Council of Texas issued Atlantic Energy's qualified scheduling entity testing certificate on October 19, 2023, which allows the company to begin its testing and qualification requirements. Atlantic Energy states that this process generally takes less than one month and requested a December 5, 2023 deadline to cure the deficiencies in this application. Atlantic Energy states that Commission Staff is agreeable to the requested extension.

The administrative law judge grants the requested extension and cancels Commission Staff's November 9, 2023 deadline for a supplemental recommendation on sufficiency. By December 15, 2023, Atlantic Energy must supplement the application to cure the deficiencies as described in the memoranda of Josephine Gonzalez and Ethan Blanchard, attached to Commission Staff's revised filing regarding administrative completeness of the application filed on October 10, 2023.

By December 22, 2023, Commission Staff must file a supplemental recommendation on the sufficiency of the application. If found administratively complete at that time, Commission Staff must also file its final recommendation on approval of the application.
