ORDER NO. 3 FINDING APPLICATION ADMINISTRATIVELY INCOMPLETE AND ESTABLISHING OPPORTUNITY TO CURE

This Order addresses the Commission Staff's August 17, 2023 revised filing regarding administrative completeness of the application of Atlantic Energy Texas LLC, under PURA¹ § 39.352 and 16 Texas Administrative Code (TAC) § 25.107, for an Option 1 retail electric provider certificate to provide retail electric services throughout the entire state of Texas.

On August 8, 2023, Commission Staff filed a recommendation on the sufficiency of the application.

In Order No. 2 filed on August 9, 2023, the administrative law judge found the application administratively incomplete and deficient.

On August 17, 2023, Commission Staff filed a revised filing regarding the recommendation on the sufficiency of the application.

The ALJ continues to find the application administratively incomplete and deficient. By September 11, 2023, Atlantic must cure the deficiencies as described in the memoranda of Josephine Gonzalez and Ethan Blanchard, attached to Commission Staff's revised recommendation dated August 17, 2023.

By September 27, 2023, Commission Staff must file a supplemental recommendation on the sufficiency of the application. If found administratively complete at that time, Commission Staff must also file its final recommendation on approval of the application.
